10 Tips for IRR Question Picks

- ★Don't over-rely on Dr. Beach to help you create a question.
- ★ Make sure you do preliminary research before creating a question.
- ★Don't start your question with "Should..." or "Could..." as the IRR is not an argumentative paper.
- ★ Consider starting your question with "To what extent...".
- ★ Is your question narrow enough? Consider narrowing it down with:
 - o Gender
 - Location
 - o Race
 - Socioeconomic Status
- **★**Does your question have a **★** FACTOR? Is it unique and interesting?
- ★Are you addressing the complexity of the issue? Can your question be viewed through multiple lenses?
- ★ Is your question researchable? Is it possible to find relevant and credible sources on your topic?
- **★**Make sure your question does not show bias.
